This study, which was launched in December 2019, aims to take stock of the achievements made since Morocco has been granted an Advanced Status by the European Union, to assess the impact of the changes in the European area on the relations of this organization with Morocco and to reflect on the future prospects of the Moroccan-European relationship and their harmonization with the Kingdom's new development model. Distinguished European think tanks are also involved in this study.

2021 Strategic Report: The Future of the Oceans

IRES has launched work on its 2021 strategic report, dedicated to the future of the oceans in an international context marked by the declaration of the United Nations's 2020 decade of Ocean Sciences for Sustainable Development. This report will attempt to make proposals for ocean conservation and for the rational use of ecosystem services at both national and international level.

The water issue in Morocco

IRES received the provisional report of the study on the water issue according to the NEXUS "Agriculture-Water-Energy-Ecosystem" approach, which will be a means that useful to optimize the allocation decisions of the resources.

Security governance in Africa

The drafting of the report on the study on security governance in Africa was completed in December 2019.

As part of the Institute's work on the African continent, this study aime to assess the security situation at the continental level, analyzes security governance within African bodies and makes proposals for its improvement, highlighting Morocco's potential contribution to this process.

The intergenerational solidarity



This sixth edition attended by many delegations chaired by Heads of State and Government, was devoted to the challenges of multilateralism and to the search for new methods of cooperation in matters of African security.

"Middle East Peace Forum"

IRES researchers participated in the first edition of the Middle East Security Forum, organized by the Chinese Institute for International Studies, on the topic: "Security in the Middle East in the new situation: challenges and prospects", held in Beijing on November 27 and 28, 2019.

The Forum emphasized the role of China in seeking equitable solutions to the conflicts in the Middle East, whether within the bodies of the United Nations (UN), in particular the Security Council, or bilaterally, in particular through its project "the New Silk Road".

2019 Global Think Tank Summit

IRES participated in the 2019 World Summit of the Best Think Tanks, organized in Rio De Janeiro between December 11 and 13, 2019 by the Think Tank and Civil Societies Program, under the University of Pennsylvania, and the Brazilian Think Tank "Fundação Getúlio Vargas".

The summit, which was attended by nearly 100 senior representatives of international Think Tanks, focused on the global transitions and turbulence of the world order as well as on the various challenges that the Think Tanks are confronted with, in a context marked by the emergence of disruptive technologies.
