Trusted Artificial Intelligence: a lever of change for Morocco's accelerated development

The Institut Royal des Etudes Stratégiques (IRES) has finalized the report summarizing the proceedings of its "Artificial Intelligence Think Tank". The report outlines the fundamentals of Artificial Intelligence, as well as its various challenges, including ethical ones. It also made a number of strategic proposals designed to outline a national strategy for the deployment of inclusive, trusted, and beneficial Artificial Intelligence, in line with the Kingdom's needs and values.

What is Morocco's relationship with the enlarged BRICS Group?

The interim report of this study on relations between Morocco and the enlarged BRICS Group highlighted the group's political, economic, social, and environmental prospects, as well as its potential impact on the evolution of the world order. It also provided an opportunity to analyze relations between Morocco and the enlarged BRICS group and to highlight the full range of possibilities for Morocco's alliances with this group.

Relations between Morocco and Nigeria

This study, whose provisional report has just been drawn up, provides an overview of the political and economic situation in Nigeria. It highlights the dynamics of cooperation between Morocco and Nigeria in various fields and explores areas for investment at the bilateral level and within continental bodies.

Emerging concepts: Attention Economy and Liminality

Continuing its new series entitled "Emerging Concepts," on March 5 and April 5, 2024, IRES published two new emerging concepts on its prospective intelligence platform - IIP: Attention Economy and Liminality.

Annual Survey Paper 2024

IRES has launched work on the 2024 edition of its "Annual Survey Paper" series. The aim of this new IRES annual publication is to present public and private players and decision-makers with the main emerging trends to bear in mind when drawing up short and medium-term strategies or action plans. It targets trends in each of the five pillars that define the IRES reading grid and highlights their impact on Morocco, its natural environment, its population, its various sectors of activity, and its future.

Trusted Artificial Intelligence: a lever for change in favor of accelerated development in the Kingdom

On March 4, 2024, IRES, in conjunction with the "Al movement" Center at Mohammed VI Polytechnic University, organized a day of forward thinking on the theme of "Trusted Artificial Intelligence: A Lever for Change in Favor of Accelerated Development in the Kingdom."

Bringing together a panel of international, African, and Moroccan experts in the fields of Artificial Intelligence, digital innovation, and cybersecurity, this meeting provided an ideal opportunity to highlight the foundations and contributions of Artificial Intelligence on a global scale, to identify the various challenges involved in its development, and to take stock of the situation in Africa and Morocco.



The first Arab Water Summit

Mr. Mohammed Tawfik MOULINE, Director General of IRES, was the keynote speaker at the first Arab Water Summit on the theme of "Culture and Heritage," organized by the Rabat Faculty of Science in collaboration with the Water Embassy and the Miftah-Essaad Foundation for Morocco's intangible capital, on March 5, 2024.

Mr. MOULINE's talk focused on the water crisis worldwide, in the Arab world, and in Morocco. Proposals were put forward concerning the governance to be implemented to better preserve water capital in the Arab region.



Solidarity, identity and language in Morocco

A seminar on "Solidarity, identity, and the language issue in Morocco" was held at IRES on March 19, 2024, as part of the Institute's study program on "The social bond in Morocco: what role for the State and all social players?"

The meeting was attended by representatives of national institutions working in this field.



The future of relations between Morocco and the United Arab Emirates

On April 22, 2024, the Institute organized, in collaboration with the Euro-Mediterranean University of Fez and the Office of His Highness Sheikh Mohammed bin Zayed Al Nahyan, an international colloquium at the University's headquarters, under the theme: "Between Morocco and the United Arab Emirates: Experiences and Visions in the Field of Development and Institutional Strengthening."

This event is in keeping with the exemplary bilateral relations that the Kingdom of Morocco and the United Arab Emirates have enjoyed for many years and the strong ties between the two countries, covering all fields and sectors and serving as an inspiring model for joint Arab action.



High-level Omani delegation visits IRES
